# TOWN WATER PROJECT: WATER CONSERVATION IN EFFECT UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE

**IMPORTANT INFORMATION:** The Water Tank is being drained and placed out of service. This is to allow for the painting and cleaning of the inside of the tank. The town will be receiving water from the Kirby Hill Tank with both Master Pits on the Liberty St and Main Street side providing water to the town. Pressure amounts will be affected. We are asking everyone to be courteous to your neighbor and NO WASHING OF VEHICLES, WATERING OF LAWNS, FILLING OF POOLS OR EXCESS OR UNNECESSARY WATER USE. By doing so, everyone will still have water. The contractor will be working 7 days a week (weather permitting) which will allow for the tank to be placed back in service soon Fire hydrants will be bagged during this phase of the work

All water meters will be changed out with radio read meters. This feature will allow the town to know if a water leak is present much sooner. Fire hydrants will be replaced along with 10 valves in the water system which will allow for leaks to be repaired and isolated. This will prevent the system from being completely shut down to repair leaks, providing for a more favorable water supply to the residents in time of a water leak or line break.

Phase 1 of the project started on April 28, and the master pit along Main Street was completed on April 30<sup>th</sup>.

It is highly recommended that if you haven't done so yet, to please sign up for the Emergency Alert that can be received via text and/or email in the event we need to update or notify our citizens.

### **Emergency Notification System**

The town now has a way to Mass communicate with residents and or family members who reside in West Milford or out of state who want to be kept up to date on various activities in the town. These can be notifications for *Water Breaks, Boil Water Advisories, Weather related emergencies, Neighborhood Watch, Weather related emergencies and General activities in the community*. The system is called WENS-Wireless Emergency Notification System. This is a <u>FREE</u> service. However, you will need to sign-up for this free service. You will receive email and/or text messages to what is occurring in our community. To signup, Type the following into your browser to get started:

#### alerts.harrisoncountywv.com

This will bring up a screen showing *"Harrison County Alerts"* choose <u>West Milford</u>, you will then receive a screen that will allow you to enter your information, then click on the items that you would like to receive emails or text messages to alert you to whatever is occurring in the community. Once you have completed the items you are interested in receiving information for, scroll down and complete your registration.

Emails and text messages will come from an acronym WMWS-Which is short for West Milford Water System.

This service is being provided to us by Harrison County Commission and the Harrison County Office of Emergency Management.
